

To facilitate a broad discussion on the scientific potential of the *Sentinel 1, 2, and 3 measurements and products*, beyond those provided by operational services, but which could significantly advance the scientific progress in Land Surface-Solid Earth-Ocean-Cryosphere system research, **ESA** in support of the **SEN4SCI** project consortium is organising an Assessment and Consolidation workshop which will take place:

22-25 March 2011 at ESA-ESRIN

All experts from the broad scientific community are cordially invited to actively participate in the discussions. Scientists interested in contributing with a thematic oral presentation related to key challenges of the research disciplines are encouraged to submit an abstract to **ESA-ESRIN** (www.sen4sci.org).

The programme items:

- Keynote presentations of the Sentinel projects and the **GMES** Services reporting on the actual state of the mission implementation and operational products
- Parallel splinter workshops devoted to Land Surface, Solid Earth, Ocean, and Cryosphere research, discussing in detail their scientific product requirements. The discussions will be stimulated by solicited key-notes covering the main scientific challenges of the different research disciplines.
- Identification of new scientific products and their technical requirements, which potentially can be derived from the Sentinels, their instrument synergies and synergies with **ESA**'s Earth Explorer and Third Party Missions, including draft proposals of processing and validation schemes.
- A closing plenary session at which the findings of the splinter workshops will be presented. A discussion on priorities, cross-comparison and technical feasibility will conclude the workshop.

LOCATION:

The workshop and its splinter workshop will be held at **ESA-ESRIN**, Frascati, Italy.

PARTICIPATION:

The workshop is open to all interested scientists. Registration is mandatory and possible using the meeting web page. No participation fee will be charged.
